### **Things to do:**

Pine Canyon features glorious mountain peak views, richly landscaped common areas, and trout-filled lakes.

Trout Creek Park is Pine Canyon's community recreation area, providing the chance to enjoy outdoor activities and family leisure. The park boasts a ramada with barbecue grills, a custom children's playhouse, restroom facilities, and playground equipment with slides, swings, and rock wall. In addition, the park features a shuffleboard area, horseshoe activities and badminton court. Trout Creek is stocked with Rainbow Trout for family-oriented fishing.

Pine Canyon offers some of the best hiking trails in the area – both adjacent to the community and in the greater Flagstaff area. Go ahead. Chase the horizon and experience outdoor living at its peak. A short two-mile hike from Pine Canyon will lead you to the spectacular Walnut Canyon, where the Sinagua Indians built their dwellings on the cliff faces, sheltered in caves more than 800 years ago. In 1915, it was declared a national monument.

### **Upper Lake Mary Near Flagstaff**

Upper Lake Mary is about 12 miles southeast of Flagstaff, Arizona in a heavy forested area in the Flagstaff Ranger District of the Coconino National Forest. It is a beautiful sky blue lake surrounded by Ponderosa Pines and meadows with views of the [San Francisco Peaks](#). The "Upper Lake" is not to be confused with its twin sister, "Lower Lake Mary" which is significantly smaller

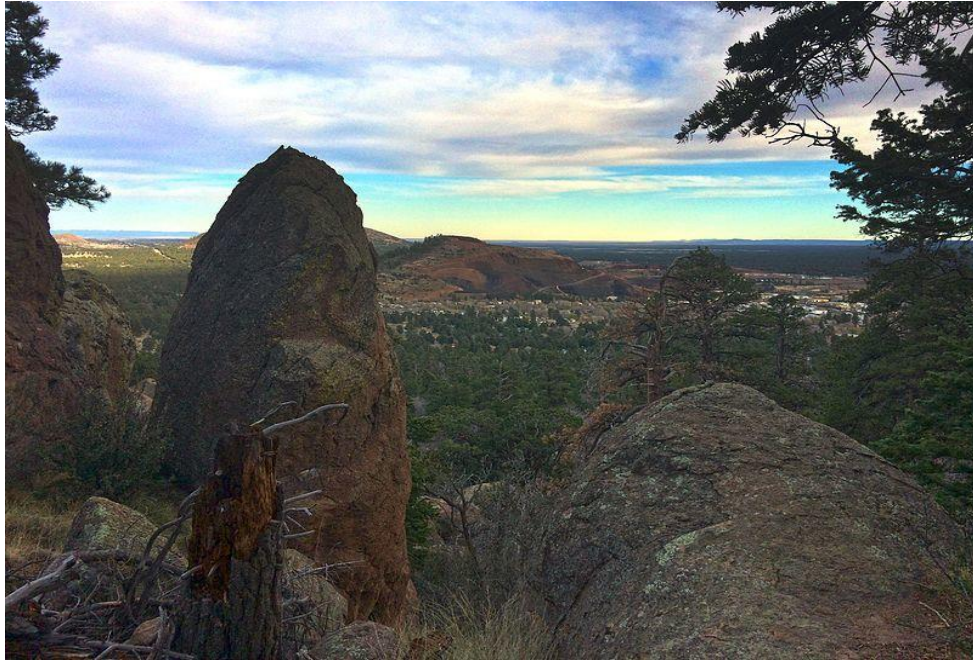
Upper Lake Mary is a long and narrow lake that is popular with power boaters and water-skiers. But you'll also see sailboats, kayaks, canoes and even rubber rafts. With its high elevation of about 7,000 feet, expect refreshing summer temperatures.

### [Abineau & Bear Jaw Loop Trail](#)

One of the main reasons why nature lovers find themselves flying down to Arizona so frequently is Abineau & Bear Jaw Loop Trail - a scenic 6.9-mile (11.10-km) loop trail situated in Flagstaff. Lined with charming wildflowers and beautiful ponderosa pines, it is easy to see why adventure seekers are so in love with this trail. You'll have the chance to view the Grand Canyon as you maneuver through the forested paths. Whichever trail you decide to follow, you'll come across steep places filled with conifer and aspen. Waterline Road is where the trails end, near Humphreys Peak.





### [Kachina Trail](#)

Starting from the Snowbowl parking lot and snaking all the way across the picturesque San Francisco Peaks is a spell-binding, 10.2-mile (16.42-km) out-and-back walking trail situated near Flagstaff. It sees a high volume of hikers and tourists looking for thrilling outdoor adventures. The exciting feature about this hiking trail is that it connects Humphreys Peak Trail and Weatherford Trail. As you traverse the wilderness, you'll be treated to breathtaking views of Agassiz Peak, the aspen groves, and open meadows. During the summer, you'll be charmed by the beautiful colors of lupine and penstemon, among a variety of other wildflowers.





### Inner Basin Trail

Discover one of the hidden gems of Flagstaff by exploring this charming and well-trekked trail in Arizona: Inner Basin Trail. This is a 3.2-mile-long (5.15 km) trail that will excite you with its spell-binding scenery covered with beautiful wildflowers. It's a lovely place to bring your dog for a walk or come and enjoy a romantic walk with your better half. Wander in the lush alpine environment and enjoy the fresh air in this charming scenery. Start your adventurous hike at Lockett Meadow and savor the tranquility in the pines and aspens.
